ORDER NO. 4-2002

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2002, the Columbia County Board of Commissioners heard the petition to name a private road. The Commissioners can name a private road if citizens so request, and it is determined by the Director of Land Development Services that circumstances exist where it would serve the public and be beneficial to the County; and


WHEREAS, the Earl J. McMurray Trust, c/o Stanley Gish, hereinafter referred to as "the Trust", has filed a petition to name a new private road. In processing this request, the following was done:

1. A petition was received on December 28, 2001 to allow the McMurray Trust to name a new private road "*Breezy Ridge Lane*"; and
2. A Board Communication was prepared, summarizing the background information of the issue and scheduling and agenda item for the next available public meeting; and
3. The proposed application for a road name meets criteria set forth in Section VII, Rad Names, of Ordinance No. 81-6 as amended, specifically subsection 7.04, regarding the naming of private roads; and
4. Staff, the St. Helens Fire Marshall, and relevant agencies have reviewed the applicants 3 choices and find no conflicting existing road names.


