ORDER NO. 105-2002

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2002, a petition was filed by Jack White to rename "Depot Road;
and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2002, the Columbia County Board of Commissioner's heard the
petition to rename Depot Road. The Commissioner's can rename a road if citizens so request and it is
determined by the Director of Land Development Services that circumstances exist where it would serve
the public and be beneficial to the county; and

WHEREAS, when staff processed this request, the following was done:

1. A Board communication was prepared, summarizing background information of the
issue and scheduling an agenda item for the next available public meeting; and
2. It was determined that the proposed application for a road name meets criteria set forth
in Section VII, Road Names, of Ordinance #81-6 as amended; specifically Subsection
7.02 and 7.05 regarding the renaming of County roads with a conflicts; and
3. Staff, the Clatskanie Fire Marshall, Columbia 911 and relevant agencies have reviewed
the applicant's 1st, 2nd and 3rd choices. It has been determined that there is a conflict
with name choices 1 and 3.
4. Staff and agencies recommend "Depot Road" be renamed to "Westward View Lane".

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Depot Road be renamed "*Westward View
Lane*" and that the applicant, Jack White, purchase the road name sign, post, and hardware and install
the sign within 90 days.
