WHEREAS, the Animal Control Fund received funds in the form of a loan from the General Fund in December 1997, the amount of \$28,000 to purchase a truck; and

WHEREAS, this Animal Control Fund has not received enough revenues to repay this loan in the past four year; and


WHEREAS, the Animal Control Fund has had a deficit fund balance since the inception of this loan; and

WHEREAS, this deficit fund balance reflects negatively on the management of the County in the audit report.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to eliminate the loan of \$28,000 from the General Fund to the Animal Control Fund.
