WHEREAS, in a letter dated October 11, 2002, St. Helens City Administrator Brian Little advised that the City Council had accepted the Board of County Commissioners offer to transfer title to three parcels of County-owned property located within the City limits to the City of St. Helens; and

WHEREAS, the three County-owned parcels are described and given a current assessed value as follows:

- 2. This conveyance shall be by Quitclaim Deeds, duly prepared by County Counsel and executed by the Board of Commissioners.
