ORDER NO. 93-2002

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2002, Steven P. Matiaco, hereinafter referred to as "the applicant", filed a petition to name a new private road; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2002, the Columbia County Board of Commissioner's heard the petition to name a private road. The Commissioner's can name a private road if citizens so request and it is determined by the Director of Land Development Services that circumstances exist where it would serve the public and be beneficial to the county; and


WHEREAS, when staff processed this request, the following was done:

1. A Board communication was prepared, summarizing background information of the issue and scheduling an agenda item for the next available public meeting; and
2. It was determined that the proposed application for a road name meets criteria set forth in Section VII, Road Names, of Ordinance #81-6 as amended; specifically Subsection 7.04 regarding the naming of private roads; and
3. Staff, the Scappoose Fire Marshall and relevant agencies have reviewed the applicant's 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> choices and finds no conflicting existing road names with the 1<sup>st</sup> choice.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the new private road, located along property known as tax account #4219-000-00800, Lots 4, 11, 18 and 19 of Koehler Acres Subdivision, be named "**Healey Lane**".
