In the Matter of Authorizing the Allocation
of County Funds for Public Purposes- SAFE
and Every Child Columbia County

ORDER NO. 63-2022

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 96-8 authorizes the Board of Commissioners to allocate County funds to private non-profit corporations upon the Board finding that such funds will be used to promote a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, a public purpose is any activity encouraged by the County which has the objective of enhancing the public health, safety, morale, general welfare, security, prosperity, and contentment of all the inhabitants or residents within the County; and

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2022, Every Child Columbia County, through Riverside Community Outreach, requested a donation in the amount of \$1200 to support its Foster Family Night Out; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that a donation to Every Child Columbia County through Riverside Community Outreach will promote the public health, safety, morale, general welfare, security, prosperity, and contentment of all residents within the County by supporting foster families and foster involved children in the community; and

WHEREAS, in support of Domestic Violence Awareness Month, the Board of County Commissioners intends to donate \$1500 to SAFE of Columbia County to provide educational materials related to domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that a donation to SAFE of Columbia County for domestic violence awareness will promote the public health, safety, morale, general welfare, security, prosperity, and contentment of all the residents within the County by providing prevention and intervention services in the community and support to survivors of domestic abuse and sexual abuse;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HEREBY ORDERS that the following payments are directed to be paid out of the County's Economic Development Fund:

1. \$1500 to SAFE of Columbia County for educational materials in support of its mission. No contract shall be required. SAFE of Columbia County shall report back to the Board of Commissioners to establish that the donation was used for the intended purpose as described herein.

2. \$1200 to Riverside Community Outreach/Every Child Columbia County in support of its mission, specifically the Family Night Out event. No contract shall be required. Riverside Community Outreach/Every Child Columbia County shall report back to the Board of Commissioners to establish that the donation was used for the intended purpose as described herein.


