The Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 99-01.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to ORS 203.035.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a procedure for setting fees for animal control services.

SECTION 4. PROCEDURE FOR ESTABLISHING USER FEES FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES.

The Board may establish user fees for animal control services by order or resolution duly adopted at a public meeting of the Board. Pursuant to ORS 203.115, a fee once set may not be changed within one year after setting the fee.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

If, for any reason, any portion of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion of the ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

THIS ORDINANCE, BEING IMMEDIATELY NECESSARY FOR THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY, AN

ORDINANCE NO. 99-01

EMERGENCY IS DECLARED TO EXIST, AND THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE.
