The above matter came on regularly before the Board of County Commissioners on the 22 day of <u>lecember</u>, 1916.

It appearing to the Board of County Commissioners that, pursuant to ORS 215.110, the governing body of the County may enact ordinances controlling the location, construction, maintenance, repair and alteration of buildings and other structures, and, in addition, ORS 203.035 to ORS 203.065 provide for the enactment of ordinances over matters of County concern; and

It further appearing to the Board of County Commissioners that the Columbia County Planning Commission at a regular meeting held April 7, 1975 made a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners that the 1973 edition of the Uniform Building Code prepared by the International Conference of Building Officials, and the 1973 edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code prepared by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, together with certain amendments, be adopted for the area of Columbia County outside the incorporated cities

therein; and

It further appearing to the Board of County Commissioners that this Building Code, as amended, and Plumbing Code, as amended, does conform to the standards set forth in ORS 215.055, and that these codes do further the goals of the Comprehensive Plan and that the adoption of this ordinance is in the best interest of the public, and the Board of County Commissioners being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Commissioners of Columbia County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Building Code Ordinance, No. 204, adopted by Board of County Commissioners on the 21st day of May, 1975 is and shall be affirmed and shall continue in full force and effect except as to the amendments thereof that appear in Section 2 herein.

Section 2. Section 302(D) of the 1973 edition, Uniform Building Code, the body of which is adopted by Ordinance No. 204, is and shall be hereby amended by adding the following language to said section, to-wit: The Board of County Commissioners may allow for the suspension of the application of Section 302(D) of the 1973 Uniform Building Code if, after application by the holder of a permit which will become invalid for failure to commence work or become invalid because work has been suspended, said applicant can show good cause supported by probative evidence that said section should be suspended.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the <u>22</u> day of <u>March</u>.
