THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR COLUMBIA COUNTY, OREGON  
 ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - Title: Columbia County Indexing Fee Schedule.

SECTION II - Authority: Pursuant to ORS 205.340 a fee for indexing may be charged by the county clerk, so long as said fee is set by ordinance of the County governing body.

SECTION III - Purpose: This ordinance is enacted for the purpose of compensating both the County and County clerk for rendering the indexing service.

SECTION IV - Amount: The fee required to be paid to the clerk by any person having an instrument recorded shall be \$4.00 plus \$1.00 indexing fee for the first page and \$4.00 per page thereafter.

SECTION V - Severability: If any portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent portion and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

SECTION VI - Repeal: All previously adopted ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict and no further, are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII - Emergency Clause: This ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public health,

safety and welfare, and being necessary to establish comprehensive planning and zoning in unplanned and unzoned portions of Columbia County, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
