ORDINANCE NO. 88-4

The Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to ORS 203.035.

SECTION 2. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 88-4.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Ordinance No. 87-5 to allow the Board of County Commissioners to waive the time limitations of Section 5 of that Ordinance and to make that section more readable.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.

Section 5 of Ordinance No. 87-5 is amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 5. TIME LIMITATIONS

- "a) The Courthouse docks shall not be used by a boat or vessel in excess of forty-eight consecutive hours for any one usage.
- "b) If any boat or vessel uses the Courthouse docks in excess of twelve consecutive hours for any one usage, that boat or vessel may not use the docks again for a period at least six consecutive hours.
- "c) Notwithstanding subsections a) and b) above, the Board may, by order, in its sole discretion, waive the above-mentioned time limitations for specific events or for specific periods."

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.

This Ordinance being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
