The Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 2014 - 8.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to ORS 203.035.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal Columbia County Ordinance No. 92 - 1, relating to food service licenses, because it has been superseded by ORS 624.490 and the administrative rules of the Oregon Health Authority.

SECTION 4. REPEAL.

Columbia County Ordinance No. 92 - 1 is repealed.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as a separate, distinct, and independent portion and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 92-1

The Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 92-1.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a fee schedule for Columbia County food service licenses.

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to ORS 203.035, 624.020, 624.025 and 624.510.

SECTION 4. ADOPTION.

The following fee schedule is adopted as the fee schedule for Columbia County food service licenses.

<u>CATEGORY</u>	<u>ANNUAL FEE</u>
Full Service Restaurants	\$ 195.00
Limited Service	\$ 50.00
Bed and Breakfast	\$ 95.00
Temporary	\$ 75.00

SECTION 5. AMENDMENTS.

The Board may, from time to time, consistent with ORS 203.115, amend the fee schedule for food service licenses by order or resolution.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.

If, for any reason, any portion of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion of the ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

This ordinance, being immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Columbia County, an emergency is declared to exist, and it shall become effective on January 1, 1992.
