AMENDED RESOLUTION AND REGULATION

WHEREAS, the voters of Columbia County, Oregon authorize the adoption of Ordinance 77-1, commonly called the Columbia County Social Gambling Ordinance; said authorizion coming from an election held the 19th day of April, 1977 and certified by Roy A. Nelson, County Clerk of Columbia County, on the 22nd day of April, 1977; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance grants to the Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon authority to establish and set rules and regulations for the implementation of said ordinance, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that:

(1) License and Application Fees. All parties desiring to conduct a social game or games as defined in Ordinance 77-1 shall pay an application fee of \$ 10.00 which shall be non-refundable, for an application form to be completed prior to issuance of a license. If, after investigation by both the District Attorney and the Sheriff of Columbia County, it is determined that applicant is qualified to be licensed, applicant shall be notified that upon receipt of the payment of the sum of \$100.00 said license will be issued. Said license fee shall be due at least 10 days before commencement of said social game, and shall expire on the 31st day of December of the year in which license was issued. All licenses shall be renewable on January 1 of each succeeding year, and the annual fee shall be paid on or before the license fee, shall be paid to the Office of the Board of County Commissioners, and receipt therefor will be issued.

Payor to pay the license fee herein required shall create a right to seek appropriate judicial relief in the name of Columbia County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, as against the game conductor or parties therein involved. In addition to the legal rights herein established, the parties herein affected shall be responsible to said county for all costs and attorneys' fees expended for obtaining judicial relief.

(2) <u>Game Limits.</u> The license granted under Ordinance 77-1, after payment of the annual license fee here adopted, shall authorize those conducting social gambling games to conduct a social game where there is a maximum limit of THREE AND NO/100 (\$3.00) DOLLARS per bet and a maximum number of raises per game of three (3). Notice of these maximum limits must be posted in a conspicuous place on the premises where the social game is being conducted; failure to do so shall be an offense for which the license to operate such a game may be revoked.
