ORDINANCE NO. 92-11

The Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon
ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 92-11.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to ORS 203.035 and 609.015.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a procedure for
setting dog license fees and kennel license fees.

SECTION 4. PROCEDURE FOR ESTABLISHING DOG LICENSE FEES AND KENNEL
LICENSE FEES.

The Board may establish dog license fees and kennel license
fees by order or resolution duly adopted at a public meeting of the
Board. Pursuant to ORS 203.115, a fee once set may not be changed
within one year after setting the fee.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENTS.

- A. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 88-13 is deleted.
- B. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 88-14 is deleted.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

If, for any reason, any portion of this ordinance is held
invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction,
such portion of the ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct
and independent portion and such holdings shall not affect the
validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

This ordinance, being immediately necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Columbia County, an emergency is declared to exist, and it shall become effective on passage.
