ORDER NO. 74-89

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 89-6 the Board of County Commissioners may enact rules and regulations for the use of Columbia County Parks; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Park Maintenance Superintendent has recommended that certain rules and regulations be enacted for the use of Hudson/Parcher County Park, which rules and regulations are attached hereto, labeled Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

1. The rules and regulations which are attached hereto labeled Exhibit "A" are enacted as the rules and regulations for the use of Hudson/Parcher County Park.

2. The Columbia County Park Maintenance Superintendent, or his designee, shall give notice of the enactment of these rules and regulations by posting copies of them at or by the caretakers' residence at the park or on signs placed or erected near the main entrance of the park. The Park Maintenance Superintendent or his designee shall certify in writing to the Board the date and method of providing such notice.

Columbia County Park Rules And Regulations

1. Check out time: 2:00 p.m.
2. Operation of concessions, by special permit from the Board of County Commissioners.
3. Fires are permitted in authorized camp stoves, fireplaces or firerings only. No fire shall be left unattended or be permitted to cause damage to park facilities or areas. Every fire shall be extinguished before its users leave the park area.
4. At the discretion of the State Forestry Department, fires normally permitted in park areas may be restricted or prohibited due to high fire hazard conditions.
5. No person within a park area shall possess any loaded firearm or discharge any firearm, pellet gun, bow and arrow, slingshot or other weapon capable of injuring any person or wildlife.
6. No hunting of animals or their habitat.
7. No mutilating, defacing, damaging or removal of any park structures such as trees and shrubs, buildings, signs, fences, tables, benches, fountains, etc.
8. No horses or other large animals in the park.
9. No dogs or other pets except on a leash. No animals; other than Seeing-Eye dogs, allowed in any buildings.
10. All bottles, cans, ashes, waste, paper, garbage and other rubbish shall be placed in proper recepticles.

11. Parking only in authorized parking areas.
12. No washing of vehicles in the park.
13. Motorized vehicles on designated roads only.
14. No use or operation of any noise producing machine, vehicle, device, or instrument in a manner that in the judgement of the Park Caretaker, is disturbing to other park area visitors.
15. No use of public address systems to be used without prior permission from the Park Caretaker.
16. During quiet hours (10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.), campers shall respect the rights of others to peace and quiet.
17. No possession, discharge or causing to be discharged of any firecrackers, explosives, rockets, fireworks or other substances which could be harmful to park area visitors or resources.
18. No abusive, obscene or indecent language in park. No public demonstrations or disturbances.
19. No overnight camping for more than seven (7) days in any ten (10) day period without prior permission from the County Park Superintendent or the Board of County Commissioners.
20. Speed not to exceed five (5) miles per hour.
21. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SHALL BE ALLOWED IN PARK.

The above rules and regulations will be enforced by the Park Caretaker and the Columbia County Sheriff's Department.
