The Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 2011-2.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority of ORS 203.035.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal Amended Ordinance No. 86-9 pursuant to Oregon and federal case law.

SECTION 4. REPEAL.

Amended Ordinance No. 86-9 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate, distinct, and independent provision and the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 6. SCRIVENER'S ERRORS.

Scrivener's errors in any portion of this ordinance may be corrected by order of the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 7. EMERGENCY.

This ordinance being immediately necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
