The Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 94-4.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority of ORS 203.035.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal Ordinance No. 93-4, the "Columbia County System Development Charge Ordinance".

SECTION 4. FINDINGS.

On March 22, 1994, the electors of Columbia County voted to repeal Ordinance No. 93-4. The ballot measure to repeal the ordinance was put on the ballot pursuant to an initiative petition. Because the chief petitioners did not propose to adopt an ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 93-4, the electors' vote on March 22, 1994, is not self-actuating. Therefore, this ordinance is necessary to put the electors' vote into effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALER.

Ordinance No. 93-4 is repealed.

SECTION 6. REFUNDS.

The Columbia County Treasurer shall refund all system development charges paid on or after March 23, 1994.

SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate. distinct and independent provision and the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

This ordinance being immediately necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Columbia County, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect on April 6, 1994.
