

AMENDMENT 1 to  
PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT  
COLUMBIA HEALTH SERVICES  
TEEN AND FAMILY TRANSITION

This Amendment 1 to the Agreement is made and entered into by and between COLUMBIA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, hereinafter referred to as "County", and COLUMBIA HEALTH SERVICES, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor" dated May 22, 2024 for Teen and Family Transition Services (the "Original Agreement").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County and Contractor entered into the Original Agreement for Teen and Family Transition services on May 22, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the completion date for the Original Agreement terminated on June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding for the Teen and Family Transition services was extended through June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Original Agreement to continue the Teen and Family Transition services through June 30, 2027, and to increase the compensation paid to Contractor;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the parties above-mentioned, in consideration of the mutual promises hereinafter stated, as follows:

1. The Original Agreement is amended as follows:
  - A. Section 3, Completion Date, is amended to extend the Completion Date to June 30, 2027.
  - B. Section 4, Contractor's Services, is amended to read as follows:

Contractor's Services. Contractor agrees to operate the Teen and Family Transition Program, quarters 3-8 of the 2023-2025 biennium and quarters 1-8 of the 2025-2027 biennium, services being as described in the RFQ for Teen and Family Transition Program Services which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and is incorporated herein by this reference and in accordance with Contractor's proposal which is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and is incorporated herein by this reference. All services to be provided under this Agreement shall be provided in conformance with Intergovernmental Agreement, Contract #15664 ("IGA #15664") between the

Oregon Department of Education Youth Development Division (the “Agency”) and County, and all amendments thereto and reinstatements thereof, which are incorporated herein by this reference and receipt of which are acknowledged by Contractor. Definitions set forth in IGA #15664 are incorporated herein. Notwithstanding the generality of the foregoing, Contractor shall specifically comply with all Grantee requirements in Section 10 of IGA #15664: Confidential Information, and will comply with the Business Associate Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 3, and is incorporated herein by this reference. When notice is required to be given under either Section 10 or the Business Associate Agreement, Contractor shall give notice to the County’s contract representative. In case of conflict between this Agreement and its exhibits, the Agreement shall control followed by Exhibits 1 and 2 in that order.”

C. Section 5, Consideration, is amended to read as follows:

“County shall pay Contractor on a fee-for-service basis, a total amount not to exceed \$139,129.25, said amount to be the complete compensation to be paid by County to Contractor for the services performed under this Agreement. This fee shall include all expenses. This Agreement is subject to the appropriation of funds by County, and/or the receipt of funds from state and federal sources. This Agreement is subject to the appropriation of funds by County, and/or the receipt of funds from state and federal sources. In the event sufficient funds shall not be appropriated, and/or received, by County for the payment of consideration required to be paid under this Agreement, then County may terminate this Agreement in accordance with Section 17 of this Agreement.

Payments shall be made quarterly in equal amounts. Payments shall be made upon receipt of funds by the County.”

2. This Amendment 1 to the Original Agreement is effective on the date last signed, below, and shall be retroactive to July 1, 2025.
3. Except as explicitly amended herein, the Original Agreement remains in full force and effect.

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- 4. This Amendment 1 to the Original Agreement may be executed in several counterparts (facsimile or otherwise) all of which when taken together shall constitute one agreement binding on all Parties, notwithstanding that all Parties are not signatories to the same counterpart. Each copy of this Amendment so executed shall constitute an original.
