The Parks Advisory Committee reviews, advises, and makes recommendations to the Columbia County Board of Commissioners and parks staff on matters related to the county's park and marine facilities. This includes long-range planning, development, design, and specific budget considerations. Committee members also advocate for park needs to decision-makers and the public and participate in events to promote park facilities and activities.

The Parks Committee has two (2) vacant seats.
