If NEXT is sending all their product to California why not produce there? The requirements are too strict. Water, energy and labor are the cheapest in the country here. Why are we being sold out.


Keep the flood gates of industrialization to this area closed. Protect our farmlands. Protect endangered and threatened wildlife. Protect our small town ways of life.




