



Recording Fee Notice

Effective July 1, 2026: Recording fees for certain documents recorded with the Columbia County Clerk's Office will increase from \$91 to \$101 for the first page.

Who is affected?

This change may affect you if you need to record a property-related document with the Columbia County Clerk's Office.

Examples include deeds, mortgages, easements, powers of attorney, land sale contracts, and similar documents recorded on or after July 1, 2026.

How much will it cost?

Fee	Through June 30, 2026	Beginning July 1, 2026
First Page	\$91	\$101
Each Additional Page	\$5	\$5

Recording a death certificate?

There will be a reduction to death certificate recording fees. The fee to record a death certificate will be \$81 for the first page and \$5 for each additional page.

Why is the fee changing?

Oregon law now requires an additional \$10 fee on certain recorded documents to support the Public Land Corner Preservation Fund.
