

## NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF BALLOT TITLE AND MEASURE ELECTION

Filed in the Office of County Clerk 2/2/2026.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a ballot title for a measure referred by Scappoose Public Library District has been filed with the Columbia County Clerk on February 2, 2026. The measure election will be conducted by mail and will be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2026.

The ballot title caption is: **Five-Year Levy to Maintain Library Services**

### **CAPTION**

Five-Year Levy to Maintain Library Services

### **QUESTION**

Shall Scappoose Public Library District maintain services by levying 10¢ per \$1,000 assessed value for five years, beginning July 2026? This measure may cause property taxes to increase by more than 3%.

### **SUMMARY**

The levy would set a fixed rate of 10 cents per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. In 2026, typical homeowners with an assessed value (not market value) of \$350,000 would pay about \$35 annually.

Currently, Scappoose Public Library District is funded by a permanent tax rate of 25.36 cents per \$1000 of assessed value. The District receives additional support through grants, gifts and sponsorships that are unpredictable. The District receives no operating support from the city or county and has not sought additional revenue since first established over 30 years ago. Since 2018, circulation has increased over 50% and facility use has increased over 25%.

This five-year levy would help maintain and provide:

- Current hours of operation and access to books and resources for lifelong learning for everyone in the community
- Children's reading events including weekly story times and summer reading
- Weekly and monthly adult events including Movies in the Park
- Expanded eBook collection available to Scappoose Library patrons exclusively
