Community Survey Response:

Casey went over survey responses and compared them to the responses gathered in 2007. Data will be used to revise the Parks Master Plan. Dibblee Beach Improvements:

Bob Rice, Oregon Equestrian Trails (OET), presented the OET Dibblee Beach Improvement Proposal. OET hosts several clean-up events at Dibblee Beach and has interest in seeing it developed further as an equestrian friendly park. The proposal included trailer parking (day and overnight), corrals, and wayfinding signage. The location is a good stopping point for people traveling with horses. OET will look for grants for corrals.

Casey will be working with OET and other interest groups to create a multi-user space.

Master Plan:

Survey results will be used to update the master plan. The master plan is used to make changes to the System Development Charge rates and apply for grants. Laurel Beach will need to be removed and Dibblee added. Lindsay will begin making edits for committee review.
