Project Status:

- CW restroom
 - Permit is final/complete
 - o Mike Smith to help install water meter in utility closet to monitor use
 - Need to overlay new shower floor slope for drainage to work correctly
 - Need to install door closures and finish trim around mirrors
- Online reservation integration
 - o Still held up in Counsel and IT review
 - Recommend meeting with BOCC to move forward with vendor's standard contract.
- CZ Trail
 - Trail head improvements beginning soon
- Dibblee Beach
 - Craig Smith will move storage container on site this coming Friday
 - Several calls to carport company to lock in install date having a little trouble making contact, but will happen soon.
 - o Access Road and Pebble Beach improvements made this summer
 - Need to install several signs throughout park
 - Boat Parking
 - Horse Trails/Parking, BCX operations, Yield signage
 - Welcome to Dibblee wood sign(s)
 - o Moving pay Kiosk and adding one for Pebble Beach access
- Scappoose RV
 - K Schwarz Construction tentatively scheduled to start site work mid-October
 - o Facilities Staff/Easter Seals maintenance support
- Prescott Beach
 - Brush Clearing project making slow progress and will speed up dramatically once we have Flail Mower equipment.
 - Carr Slough Restoration, Grant Process
