Jail Volunteers

Volunteers serve at the discretion of the County Sheriff. The position of volunteers is “at will” and the volunteer may be dismissed at any time, for any reason, with or without cause. This is not a compensated position.

Job Description

The Jail Volunteer position has been developed to support the mission of the of the Columbia County Sheriff's Office/Corrections Division. To further the mission, we are seeking volunteer Pastors, Narcotics Anonymous, Alcoholic Anonymous, Mental Health Counselors, and Educators to come into our jail and educate the jail population and give them the necessary tools so that, when they get out of jail, they can become productive members of society.

Minimum General Requirements

High School Diploma or G.E.D., must be a minimum of eighteen (18) years of age, a United States citizen.

Must possess a valid Oregon Driver's License or State identification card.

Must have transportation.

Must successfully pass a background examination.

Must complete oral interviews.

Must present a professional appearance and friendly manner.

Must be dependable and punctual.

Must be courteous and personable when dealing with the public.

Must be self-directed and detail oriented.

Must respect and maintain confidentiality.

Computer skills are desired, but not necessary

Additional Information

Commitment of one year of service for volunteer with a minimum of 4-8 volunteer hours per month.

Commitment to attend ongoing meetings, in-service training and education workshops.
