This Permit is required by the Columbia County Transportation Ordinance 86-3 for all vehicles in excess of 26,000 pounds GVW and hauling 75% of their legal maximum axle weight or more, on the above listed roads. The Operator must obtain a permit for the Restricted Roads to be used, and for each vehicle to be used. Subject to the following terms and conditions below, and pursuant to the Columbia County Transportation Ordinance and ORS 818.010 to 818.440. Permittee is hereby authorized to move the listed Commodity on the listed vehicle over the named Restricted Roads, as set forth herein.

Permit Conditions:

Posted Road Limits. Nothing in this Permit shall authorize travel across roads or bridges with a posted weight restriction, including winter freeze/thaw restrictions, unless specifically authorized in the special provisions written above.

Coverage and Applicability. The equipment and load covered by this Permit shall conform to the Oregon Motor Vehicle Laws and the Oregon Motor Transportation Code as the same may be modified by the provisions of this permit. This Permit must be carried at all times in the cab of the vehicle and must be available for inspection by any police officer, the Weighmaster, or any representative of the Columbia County Public Works Department.

Cancellation. This Permit may be revoked at any time by the County Roadmaster if, in the Roadmaster's judgement, it is in the public interest to do so.

Acceptance of Conditions. The receipt of this Permit by the Permittee and initiation of any movement authorized thereby shall be deemed acceptance by the Permittee of all descriptions, terms and conditions set forth herein.

Crossing Highway/Centerline/Clearance. The movement authorized hereby shall at all times keep to the extreme right hand side of the traveled roadway, On two lane highways when the roadway width is such that any portion of the movement extends over, beyond or to the left of the centerline of the traveled roadway, except when overtaking or passing other vehicles or an obstruction on the highway, the Permittee shall furnish a flagger-escort to precede the load and warn approaching traffic, whether or not such flagger-escort is required on the face of this Permit.

Speed. The Permittee shall at all times operate at a reasonable speed giving due consideration to the existing conditions.

Indemnity. The Permittee, Owner and Property Owner, as listed above, shall be jointly and severally liable and shall indemnify the County, its officers, agents and employees from any claim for damage to property or person that might arise out of the granting of this Permit or the use of the Restricted Roads under this permit. The County Roadmaster may require the Permittee, Owner and/or Property Owner to furnish indemnity insurance or an indemnity bond, in an amount fixed by the County Roadmaster, to secure such indemnity.

License and PUC Permit. Vehicles to be used on any road within the County's jurisdiction shall be properly licensed in the State of Oregon and shall carry the proper PUC certificate and plate or pass.

Temporary Revocation. The Board of County Commissioners, acting through the County Roadmaster, may at certain times, temporarily revoke this Permit and declare posted roads closed to vehicles operating in excess of the posted weight limitation. Any revocation decision shall be made by the Roadmaster based upon his/her judgement and discretion and may be effective immediately if necessary to protect the Restricted Roads.

Premium Fee: For hauling during the months of January-May and October-December, no hauling shall occur under this Permit unless and until the Property Owner of the property where the Commodity originates pays a premium fee of \$5.00 per trip per mile or fraction thereof, or \$1.00 per trip per Thousand Board Feet or fraction thereof for timber hauling. Payment of the Premium Fee does not relieve the Permittee, Owner, or Property Owner from liability for damage to the Restricted Roads or from damage to persons or property as set forth above.

By signing below, Permittee and Owners covenant that the weight of the Vehicle cannot be reduced as provided in ORS 810.210 and agree to be bound by covenant and abide by the Permit Conditions listed above.
