

**Columbia County
Monthly Report Form A
Natural Resource Depletion Fee**

Beginning January 1, 1997, The Columbia County Natural Resources Depletion Fee, (Ordinance 96-2) levies a fee of \$0.15 (fifteen cents) per ton for the privilege of severing and depleting natural resources from Columbia County. For the purposes of this of this ordinance, "Natural resources" includes but is not limited to coal, clay, soil, shale, sand, gravel, metallic ore, or aggregate.

On a monthly basis, all operators are required to report the weight and pay the fee for the natural resources they remove from their premises. This form along with payment should be sent to the following address no later than the last day of the month which follows the reported activity:
