Batteries can cause fires, recycle your batteries here for free.

For Columbia County residents only.

Accepted items: All cellphones, alkaline, lithium primary, coin or button cell, lithium-ion, nickel-metal hydride, nickel cadmium and non-vehicle sealed lead acid batteries under 25 lbs. Note: Lead-acid batteries are accepted for a fee.

Unaccepted items: Batteries that cannot be removed from products (except cellphones), electric vehicle batteries, battery storage systems
